

#### **Grants**

- The Grants Coordinator worked with the Finance Department and several departments and offices across the County to build, monitor, and submit more than \$660k in eligible claims for FEMA Public Assistance Projects.
  - The FEMA Grants Portal shows the Grants Coordinator made 572+ entries and uploaded more than 3,500 pages of supporting documentation for these projects.
- As a result of the County's FEMA Public Assistance Program Projects, the County was eligible to apply for and receive \$2.5M in CARES Act Local Government Relief Funding.
- In 2020, the Grants Coordinator organized five construction bid packages for the Clear Creek Watershed Improvement Project, which is funded by a \$4.3M CDBG-NDR Grant through December 31, 2021.
- On March 11, the American Rescue Plan Act was enacted. The State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund allocates approximately \$29.3M to Johnson County by population. The Grants Coordinator is working with the Finance Department to develop processes, recommendations, and resources to ensure compliance and documentation requirements are achieved.
